Dear Partners in the DRC mission,

Greeting in the name of our Lord Jesus.

We are glad to announce to you the combined effort that is lay ahead of us regarding our mission in the DRC. After visiting cities and small town in the Kongo Central Province, we find that the eyes disease is becoming a serious issue. One of the small town called Kuakua may have over fifty blinds and the number is increasing. Also the cities of Boma and Tshela are facing the same problem.

After last year visit of our General Director Paul Gossman and our colleague Gloria Sauck missionary in Kenya, we planned to conduct eyes camp in September of this year, that will help assess and treat at least 6,000 people in three cities (Boma, Kuakua and Tshela).

Sister Gloria will bring another colleague professional from Kenya and we will use DRC medical doctors, Ophtamologists, nurses and selected members of the church to form the team that will intervene in this eyes camp. At the same period we will have a visit of Dr. William Obaga, Associate Director for Africa, WMPL. He will be teaching for about two weeks in September at the Lutheran Theological College and further hold a seminar for pastors of the CELCCO.

Please pray for granting of visa for William, Gloria and her colleague from Kenya. Pray for the three weeks eyes camp, for logistic and God provision.
